

### **Agreement For Students Over 18 years of Age**

The Privacy Act of Australia requires that the German International School, its teachers and administrators, are not allowed to release information about anyone over 18 years of age without their prior consent. This means that without your consent, we can not inform your parents or guardians about your progress and your success, nor can we raise any issues of concern with them. This is an untenable situation for the German International School, where we recognize and encourage the important role played by parents in supporting students in their further education at the school, especially in a demanding programme such as the IB Diploma.

We therefore ask that you sign the following agreement so that we can contact your parents and guardians, and thereby release relevant information to them about you. We strongly believe that having such an agreement in place is in the best interests of the students concerned.
